FAR EASTERN STATE MEDICAL UNIVERSITY (FESMU) GUIDE for ADMISSION OF FOREIGN CITIZENS

Foreign citizens are eligible to receive higher education in accordance with the following laws and rules,

1. at the expense of budget appropriations in accordance with international treaties of the Russian Federation and federal laws. As part of the general competition for free state-funded (budgetary) places, the following categories of citizens are admitted on a general basis: citizens of Belarus, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan and Tajikistan living abroad (according to the Agreement of 1996), citizens of Azerbaijan, Armenia, Belarus, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Moldova, Tajikistan, Turkmenistan, Uzbekistan, Georgia and Ukraine having a residence permit on the territory of the Russian Federation (Agreements of 1994, 1996), compatriots and their descendants (Federal Law No. 99 dated May 24, 1999). In this case, a foreign applicant undergoes a competitive selection along with applicants from Russia. For this, the USE certificate (if available) is submitted or the applicant passes entrance examinations conducted by the FESMU independently.

2. in accordance with the quota for education of foreign citizens established by the Government of the Russian Federation (to receive the quota for admission to the FESMU, please register at EDUCATION-IN-RUSSIA.COM (<u>https://education-in-russia.com/</u>) and submit an application, mentioning the Far Eastern State Medical University as the university you want to study at. The selection of foreign citizens is carried out by the Ministry of Education and Science of Russia together with educational organizations on the basis of the documents submitted by foreign citizens.

3. at the expense of individuals and legal entities in accordance with contracts for the provision of paid educational services. For this, the USE certificate (if available) is submitted or the applicant passes entrance examinations conducted by the FESMU independently. The University independently allocates the number of places for training in Specialist's degree and Bachelor's degree programs under contracts for the provision of paid educational services for admission based on the results of entrance examinations established for foreign citizens, and holds a separate competition for these places.

In the statement of consent to enrollment, the applicant specifies the kind of competition under which he wants to be enrolled.

Foreign citizens who have graduated from school abroad, in the absence of USE results, are enrolled based on the results of entrance examinations conducted by the university independently for certain categories of applicants (it does not apply to applicants entering by quota).
